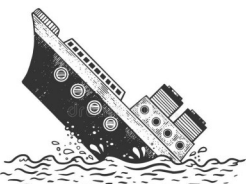
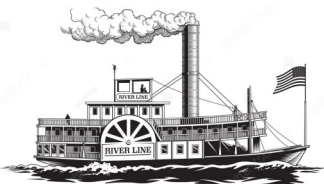
**Bellefontaine Cemetery and Arboretum
